- Testifies of the Lord – John 15:26
- Guides us – John 16:13
- Instructs us – Acts 16:6-7

### It is important for us to know what the Holy Spirit is not...

- A created being – Genesis 1:1-2. The ruach elohim, “the Breath of the Almighty,” is the agent in creation.
- Just a power but rather the power of God – Genesis 1:2, Acts 2:4.
- A force – John 14:16, 15:26
- A vague ethereal (light and weightless) shadow – Acts 1:8
- An impersonal entity – Psalm 139:7-10
- An inanimate object – 1 Corinthians 2:10

The titles given to the Holy Spirit in the Bible reveal much about His position and function. The Holy Spirit is called:

- The Spirit of God – I Corinthians 3:16
- The Spirit of Christ – Romans 8:9
- The Eternal Spirit – Hebrews 9:14
- The Spirit of Truth – John 16:13
- The Spirit of Grace – Hebrews 10:29
- The Spirit of Life – Romans 8:2
